ABOUT THIS ITEM

Opaque Petit Verdot lives up to its namesake, with a deep, dark red color that promises a profoundly rich and satisfying wine. Blackberry, currant and black plum dominate the palate, supported by mocha and vanilla crème. Aged for 18 months in French and American oak barrels - 79% new – this Petit Verdot shows great concentration and texture, spicy richness, and tannins that are long, soft and round. The wine has a long, powerful finish and the structure to age beautifully for a decade at least. Our Stefano Vineyard in the prestigious El Pomar District AVA of Paso Robles dominates this wine at 66%. This site comprises steep hillsides with unusual soils filled with multicolored rocks of all shapes and sizes. Warm daytime temperatures are punctuated by cool afternoon breezes coming off the Pacific Ocean and through the Templeton Gap. 2018 was a seminal vintage in Paso Robles, with a long, steady growing season that contributed to both ripeness and freshness in the wines. This Petit Verdot, harvested in late October, showcases the textbook power and fruit intensity of the region combined with precision and elegance.

Aging in French and American oak barrels contributes notes of vanilla and oak spice. The mouthfeel is jammy and full-bodied. Firm tannins provide structure as the flavors build to a lengthy finish. Hand-harvested in small lots, each batch is fermented individually with minimal intervention to showcase the pure expression of our California vineyards. To enhance depth and character, this dark red wine is aged in a careful selection of hand-crafted French and American oak barrels, with 78% new oak contributing to the wine's complexity. We partner with top cooperages and select diverse oak forests to bring layers of nuance to the final blend. This smooth Cabernet Sauvignon bursts with robust flavors of blackberry, ripe plum, and black cherry. The palate is round and rich, with subtle spice notes and soft, well-integrated tannins that beautifully balance its fresh acidity. Delivering a long, satisfying finish, this delectable wine pairs perfectly with grilled lamb chops seasoned with rosemary and garlic, enhancing the wine's deep, layered flavors. With an alcohol content of 14.5% ABV, San Simeon Cabernet Sauvignon is a standout among California red wines, perfect for any occasion or special meal.
